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Goals

Goal 1: Garland ISD will ensure ALL students graduate prepared for college, careers, and life by increasing student performance measures, postsecondary readiness, and graduation rates and decreasing student management incidences.

Performance Objective 1: Percent of students in grade 3 demonstrating early literacy as measured by Meets Grade Level performance on STAAR Reading, will increase from 59.6% to 70% by June 2021.

Percent of students in grade 4 demonstrating early literacy as measured by Meets Grade Level performance on STAAR Reading, will increase from 66% to 75% by June 2021.

Percent of students in grade 5 demonstrating early literacy as measured by Meets Grade Level performance on STAAR Reading, will increase from 80.7% to 85.9% by June 2021.

Performance Objective 2: Percent of students in grade 4 demonstrating early literacy as measured by Meets Grade Level performance on STAAR Writing will increase from 38.3% in 2019 to 50% by June 2021.

Performance Objective 3: Percent of ELL students demonstrating English language acquisition, as measured by earning yearly progress indicator on the Texas English Language Proficiency Assessment System (TELPAS), will increase from 54.5% in 2019 to 60% by June 2021.

Performance Objective 5: Percent of students in grade 3 demonstrating early literacy as measured by Meets Grade Level performance on STAAR Math, will increase from 65.2% to 70% by June 2021.

Percent of students in grade 4 demonstrating early literacy as measured by Meets Grade Level performance on STAAR Math, will increase from 72.3% to 78% by June 2021.

Percent of students in grade 5 demonstrating early literacy as measured by Meets Grade Level performance on STAAR Math, will increase from 77.2% to 85% by June 2021.

Performance Objective 6: Percent of student management incidents resulting in exclusionary consequences [i.e., In School Suspension (ISS), Out of School Suspension (OSS), and Reassignment Rooms] will decrease from 31.5% in 2019 to 30% by June 2021.
